In the months between April 2025 and March 2026 our team was able to care for 161 residents, representing the largest single year impact in our 15-year history! This increase in care was offset financially by the incredible support received through the Hospice Shoppe which recorded a sales record of just over \$925,000 of gross revenue! Our primary focus remains effective symptom management and supporting the highest possible quality of life for those we serve. In collaboration with programs and services across our organization, we continue to strengthen and enhance the quality of care provided to our patients.

Patients may be admitted to Bobby's Hospice from home or hospital through the following referral pathways:

**From Home:** Family physicians contact the Hospice Physician on service and the Director of Nursing.

**From Home via EMP:** EMP nursing staff contact the Director of Nursing and Hospice Physician on service.

**From Hospital:** The attending Physician refers the patient to the Palliative Medicine Service for assessment and triage.

During the last quarter, Bobby's Hospice admitted and cared for 35 patients. In the 2025–2026 fiscal year, we provided care and support to 161 patients and their families
